marks the 20th anniversary of the launch of "Health Situation in the Americas: Basic Indicators," a publication updated—annually and without interruption—the available information for a set of basic health indicators region of the Americas. During this period, the publication has been dynamically consolidated with the inclusion indicators that reflect the current health context.

of that consolidation and in order to strengthen national Health Information Systems, the Pan American Organization/World Health Organization (PAHO/WHO), in 2005, established a baseline for birth and death registration in 25 countries of the Region, making it possible to adopt a strategy and a Regional Plan of Action for Strengthening Vital and Health Statistics (CD48.R6).

Important to recognize the extensive efforts that the health statistics bureaus in the countries have made to implement the regional plan. Well aware of the importance of producing reliable, timely, valid, and accurate data, the bureaus have established processes to collect the best possible information for policy-making and monitoring, despite the various limitations they encounter.

ting these efforts, this publication focuses on the analysis of two demographic phenomena—births and deaths—for which the data production involves at least two institutions that respond to different social demands. On one hand, health systems certify both events and help to provide evidence on the epidemiological and social characteristics of persons who are born and who die, as well as reporting these events for the legal record. On the other hand, civil registries are responsible for recording these events from a legal perspective and, in many cases, for transmitting this information to the statistics bureaus that then produce official data.
